

Palm Treo 650 Smartphone



After playing around with the Windows Based PDA, I decided to try some other options, so that I could improve my knowledge.

I picked up a display model of the Palm Treo 650 Smartphone for stuff all money.

Now bearing in mind this smartphone doubles as a PDA and phone it is quite bulky and only has a 2" screen.

This device has a Palm operating system.

It plays well with both mac and PC.

I found it confusing to have a PDA combined with a smartphone. Every time I wanted to read in peace someone would ring and I would get annoyed.

Even with the font increased on mobipocket the screen was hard to read because there was only about 20 words on the screen at any one time.

It was convenient to have only one device in my pocket though.

After about 2 weeks of persevering with the screen to read my eBooks, I got the shits and offloaded this phone.

Mobipocket did install easily on Palm Operating System though.

My recommendation would be, if you already have a Treo 650 or 750, download MobiPocket and see if you like eBooks and reading on the smaller screen. This way you will be able to decide whether you like the capability before forking out for a dedicated device or larger PDA.
